CUT FLOWERS

Despite an increase in volumes of flowers coming into the market, price returns remain strong due to a healthy attendance of avid bidders throughout the week. Wednesday proves to be the highlight of the week with racks and benches festooned with floral delights covering every colour of the rainbow. A super splurge of late season Peonies has the connoisseurs licking their lips as they bid for their favourite colour assortment. Super Statice sparkles in the sunlight, with frenzied bidding for all quality entries, especially for Helichrysum bouquet selections. Oriental Lily volumes remain low, helping to keep prices on the up.

POT & GARDEN PLANTS

We can report an "ebullient feel" to the market this week, as Monday starts strong, Wednesday seeing pandemonium erupting as the buyers squeeze onto the bidding floor, all jostling for space. It's all over bar the shouting as Thursday arrives and another week is nearly over. Fully coloured Perennial plants showing off their pomp and glory are this week's "must have" plant selections, with admirers driven doolally with desire for inviting splashes of interest. Delphiniums, Lupins, Penstemons and Scabious all feature highly. Zantedeschia teeming with spikes of technicolour flowers attract a host of bids. Lavender volumes see a reduction, helping to keep prices on the healthy side.

FRUIT & VEGETABLES

A bumper selection of top quality fruit and vegetables adorn the halls throughout the week. With this in mind, buyers can afford to pick and choose their lots. The long awaited seasonal debut of local grown Runner Beans are meet by a sprint of bids, as discerning greengrocers and market traders queue up to bid, in an attempt to secure at least a showing of this new line. Cauliflower start the week on a high with only limited entries, but prices realised fall away as supplies increase. Romanesco on the other hand reaps the rewards as demand far outstrips supply.
